Environment Minister, ministry leaders and EPAP managers visit Helwan cement plant

Minister of Environment, Dr. Yamsine Fouad, visited Helwan Cement Company, a subsidiary of Suez Cement Group of Companies (SCGC), on Thursday, February 14, 2019, inspect the environmental conditions and learn about the latest developments in the company's environmental sanitation plans.
